AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents.

The grievance was that representation dated 19.11.2020 was not being considered.

From the pleadings, it is forthcoming that petitioner is having in her favour a registered 'Will' executed by her father, yet the property in question is in the possession of petitioner and his brothers and sisters.

Learned State Counsel had filed reply dated 7.3.2022. As per the pleadings, the dispute was within the family members with regard to the partition of the property. After conducting enquiry, the representation was filed. A preventive action under Section 107/151 Cr.P.C. was taken.

In view of the reply filed, no further directions are called for.

Petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance, if any.
