Vide the instant petition filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.153 dated 26.07.2021, Annexure P-1, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 and 420 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station City Rup Nagar, Annexure P-2.

Counsel representing the petitioner submits that the matrimonial dispute has been settled and a separate petition has been filed seeking quashing on the basis of compromise.

Upon instructions, State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and has co-operated with the investigation proceedings.

In view of the above, but without examining the merits of the case, present petition is allowed and order dated 18.02.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
