Petitioner has approached this Court praying for quashing of order dated 21.01.2022 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender arising out of FIR No.0054 dated 07.05.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Police, Jalandhar as the compromise has been effected between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

It has been contended by counsel for the petitioner that as already submitted before this Court that the dispute had arisen out of the matrimonial discord and all the outstanding issues have been resolved. He submits that the petitioner is presently in Australia and he would return to India on 10th January, 2023. He submits that the petitioner is keen to join proceedings for settling all the outstanding issues.

Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner that the parties have already arrived at compromise.

After hearing counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned Court that in case the petitioner arrives in India on 10th January, 2023 and appear before the concerned Court/investigating agencies as required, within two days from the date of his arrival then his arrest would remain stayed for seven days from the date of his landing in India. In case, he prefers an application for redressal of his grievances, the Court concerned would deal with and decide the same expeditiously as in accordance with law.

Needless to say that if the petitioner does not arrives in India on 10th January, 2023 as undertaken before this Court then this order would be of no avail to him.
