Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of re-exercise of option under HCS (ACP) Rules, 2016 in view of letter dated 16.06.2017 (Annexure P-3) and letter dated 08.06.2020 (Annexure P-4).

2. Petitioner, *qua* his grievance, also submitted a representation dated 09.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) but the same has not been adverted by respondents till date. Hence the petition.

3. On advance service, learned state counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by competent authority, either way, on the pending representation dated 09.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representation as suggested by learned State counsel.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the representation dated 09.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within six weeks from today.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
