Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 187 dated 30.09.2020, registered under Sections 3, 5, 6, 13 and 17 of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

The operative part of the order dated 21.10.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are some typographical mistakes in para 2 of the petition, however, it is further submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case and he has been nominated in this case being owner of the truck.

Learned counsel further submits that though the petitioner was granted interim bail by the Court of Sessions, however, he could not join investigation and consequently, his bail application was dismissed.

Notice of motion for 06.12.2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 21.10.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Kashmiri Lal, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 21.10.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
