Learned counsel for the respondents submits that though no reply is needed in the present case as the benefits for which the petitioner has approached this Court, were already released to him in January, 2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only grievance which remains to be redressed is grant of interest on the delayed release of the benefits, for which the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation keeping in view the settled principles of law laid down by Hon'ble Full Bench of this Court in the case of **A.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab and others**, **1997(3) SCT 468**.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner approaches the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation raising his claim, the same will be decided by passing an appropriate order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case, after the decision of the said representation, the

petitioner is found eligible for any relief, the same will be released to him within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further, with the liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
