has also signed the said statement today accepting the proposal made by the

counsel for the appellant.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) favouring appellant-Rajiv Kumar Garg S/o Satpal Garg with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 30.01.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
