Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners could not fill up their choice of station for transfer keeping in view the fact that the portal did not show the option of the said station while they were exercising for filling up their option and hence, the petitioners are aggrieved in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Learned State counsel submits that the last date for filling up the option was 19.08.2022 and the transfers were effected on 28.08.2022 i.e. after ten days of closing of the last date, whereas no grievance of the petitioners was ever received during the said period, which have been raised in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the petitioners are still aggrieved, they can approach the appropriate authority by filing appropriate representation.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not

pressed with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents for raising their grievances as raised in the present petition and in case the petitioners file any representation, the same shall be decided within a period of two weeks of the submission of the same.
