[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 11.10.2021, in CWP No.20189 of 2021 in case titled as '**Narender Kumar versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.20189 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide legal notice dated 10.10.2017 filed by the petitioner including the question of delay, if any, by passing a speaking order, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Today, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 17.11.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 17.11.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
