The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the quashing of the order dated 27.07.2022 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar in FIR No.45 dated 06.04.2021 under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1).

On 27.09.2022, the following order was passed in this case:-

The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing/set aside the order dated 27.07.2022 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar in case No.NDPS -110-2021 relating to FIR No.45 of 2021 Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar whereby his bail was cancelled and nonailable warrants of arrest were issued against him.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that due to certain unavoidable circumstances he was unable to appear on one date i.e. 27.7.2022 on which date the impugned order

Annexure P-1 was passed. He submits that he is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 14.12.2022.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender himself before the trial court within a period of one week from today and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court”.

Today, an application has been moved seeking extension of time to the petitioner for surrendering before the Trial Court in terms of the aforesaid order passed by this Court.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court on 03.10.2022 in terms of the order dated 08.09.2022 passed by this Court.

It is made clear that no further opportunity shall be granted to the petitioner in case he does not appear/surrender before the Trial Court on 03.10.2022”.

In compliance with the said order, the petitioner appeared and furnished his bail bonds and surety bonds on 03.10.2022. Since the petitioner has joined the proceedings, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

The petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial except for sufficient cause.
