Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.72 dated 21.4.2021 registered under Sections 384, 506 IPC at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and even otherwise, the allegations recorded in the FIR are vague and are not specific. He further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmit Singh has admitted the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and further submits that now the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 25.10.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
