The petitioner, who is working as a Senior Resident with respondent No.3, is seeking a direction to issue 'No objection Certificate' to enable him to appear in the interview for the post of Dental Surgeon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents are erroneously not issuing 'No objection Certificate' to the petitioner for appearing in the interview for the post of Dental Surgeon advertised by respondent No.5.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1, 2 and 5.

Ms. Sehaj Sandhawalia, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4 and submits that as the petitioner has not executed any bond, there is no requirement in the advertisement for submitting 'No objection Certificate'. No objection Certificate' is required only if a candidate has executed a bond. She has relied upon Clause 15 of the advertisement at Annexure P-3.

In view of the above, it is apparent that 'No objection Certificate' would not be required in the case of the petitioner as he is not stated to have executed a bond. In the event of the petitioner applying in response to the advertisement(Annexure P-3), respondent No.5 would not reject her candidature for want of submission of NOC.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
