ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.402 dated 21.09.2021, under Sections 379, 411, 465, 466, 468, 471, 473, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the basis of secret information that he along with co-accused is committing theft of vehicles after forging registration certificates. She also contends that it is alleged that a vehicle with Rajasthan registration number was coming and the driver had fled away from the spot after leaving the vehicle. There is no *prima facie* material which would connect the petitioner with the vehicle which was allegedly recovered by the police.

This Court, by the order dated 10.11.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the

satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Subhash Chand, contends that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 10.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
