This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to dispose of representation dated 25.02.2022 (Annexure P-24) for providing the copies of the proceedings of Staff Court of Inquiry dated 14.01.2015 (Annexure P-9) and proceedings of Additional Staff Court of Inquiry dated 28.02.2017 (Annexure P-15) by passing speaking orders to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Anita Balyan, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has pointed out that the petitioner had filed another writ petition, though raising claim to pro-rata pension, involving the same set of facts qua his service tenure. That writ petition was disposed of by directing the respondents to re-consider the case of the petitioner. However, the respondents have preferred the appeal bearing LPA No.525 of 2017, which is pending before the Division Bench.

In view of the fact that the matter involving the same set of facts is already pending before the Division Bench, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere in the present petition. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the dismissal of this writ petition shall not be taken as prohibition qua the rights of the petitioner to make appropriate prayers before the Division Bench.
