Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.02 dated 04.01.2019, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar (Rural), under Section 21 NDPS Act, 1985.

Vide order dated 25.10.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner was ordered to be released on interim anticipatory bail, subject to him furnishing the fresh bail/surety bonds within 10 days, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. Since the order was not complied with by the petitioner, while deciding CRM-40217-2021, one more opportunity was granted with a direction to furnish fresh bail/surety bonds within 10 days from the date of order, in terms of the aforesaid order dated 25.10.2021, but the same has also not been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that the petitioner has not complied with the interim order passed by this Court time-to-time.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid factual position and prays to dismiss the present petition.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has not complied with the interim order passed by this Court time-to-time, the petitioner does not deserve any relief as prayed for.

The petition is dismissed.
