Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.310 dated 12.10.2020 under Sections 376(2) (n), 376-D, 450, 506 of IPC (during investigation, Section 376-D of IPC has been deleted), registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner is behind bars since 14.10.2020. He has inter alia contended that there is a delay of about 04 months in lodging the FIR and the case of the prosecution is not medically corroborated. He further contends that the matter was inquired into by two senior Police Officers and the offence against the petitioner was not substantiated.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rekha, has

submitted that in all, there are 16 prosecution witnesses and all of them have already been examined and now the case is fixed for examination of the defence witnesses for 26.04.2022.

After hearing counsel for the parties, this Court does not find it appropriate to comment upon the merits of the case, as the case is virtually towards the completion of the trial, as submitted by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, this Court finds no grounds for grant of relief of regular bail to the petitioner. However, the learned trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same, expeditiously.

Disposed of with the above observations.
