HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners are entitled for the grant of salary, which is being paid to the regular Lecturers keeping in view the settled principle of law settled by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *Civil Appeal No. 213 of 2013 titled as State of Punjab and others vs. Jagjit Singh and others, decided on 26.10.2016.*

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that keeping in view the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *Jagjit Singh's case (supra)*, the salary of the Extension Lecturers has already been fixed keeping in view the minimum of pay scale of the Lecturer and in case, the petitioners have any grievance of the non-payment of the same, if raised before the authorities concerned, appropriate order will be passed within a

period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and the claim is found meritorious, appropriate relief will also be extended to the petitioners within a period of one month thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents raising the grievance as raised in the present writ petition.

Ordered accordingly.
