VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing of order dated 30.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.1, order dated 08.11.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2 and the order dated 18.10.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3, list of members published alongwith election notification dated 03.10.2019 (Annexure P-1) and the election of collegium and of executive body held on 13.10.2019 and 10.11.2019 respectively on the basis of unlawful voter list. Further prayer has also been made for issuance of the writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to conduct the election of collegiums and executive body afresh on the basis of approved voter list.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that the present

petition has been rendered infructuous inasmuch as the petitioner had raised the challenge to the order passed by Registrar General of Firms and Societies, Haryana, wherein the issue before the authorities was with regard to holding of elections on the basis of the approved list of voters/members as existed on the date of re-registration of the Society. He contends that thereafter, the fresh/new elections have already been held on 30.11.2022. He further contends that the petitioner thus could not have any subsisting grievance.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today.

However, considering the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondent No.4, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to file appropriate application seeking revival of the present petition in case any real grievance of the petitioner still survives.
