Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to the learned Lower Appellate Court i.e. Additional Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, for deciding appeal bearing CRA No.120 of 2018 titled Ravinder Singh Kadan @ Ravi and Others vs State of Punjab, arising out of judgment passed in FIR No.74 dated 08.05.2010, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 201 IPC, Police Station Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, within some specified time.

Vide order dated 10.11.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, status report of the Court concerned was called for.

In compliance thereto, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, has submitted a report vide letter dated 07.01.2022.

As per the aforesaid report, the appeal was fixed on 04.01.2022 for hearing the arguments of learned Additional PP for the State and learned counsel for the complainant assisting the State. However, on the said date,

applications for exemption were moved by the appellants praying therein that the arguments be heard in their presence. Thus, the case was adjourned to 11.01.2022 for the aforesaid purpose. It is further submitted in the report that as soon as arguments on behalf of all the parties will be concluded, the appeals would be decided, as early as possible.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case is now fixed for 27.01.2022 for hearing the remaining arguments of learned Additional PP for the State and learned counsel for the complainant assisting the State.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for.
