This is a first petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Sections 438 and 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.562 dated 07.05.2015 registered under Section 381 IPC at Police Station City Gurugram, Gurugram.
