The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Article 226 Constitution of India, praying for transfer of investigation of (1) FIR No.102 dated 04.08.2018 under Sections 353/332/225/186/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib, (2) FIR No.107 dated 26.06.2018 under Sections 323/379-B/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Lalru, SAS Nagar, Mohali and (3) FIR No.13 dated 12.02.2019 under Sections 307/332/353/186/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station City Morinda, District Ropar.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 27.08.2019, pursuant to which reply dated 12.02.2019 by way of an affidavit of Sukhjit Singh Virk, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sri Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, Punjab on behalf of respondent No.5 has been filed.
