Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for quashing of impugned order dated 31.03.2014 (P-10), whereby, arrears of revised pay scale granted to the petitioners were ordered to be recovered.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sukhwinder Singh, Senior Assistant, DPI (Colleges), Punjab, submits that the order impugned has been withdrawn and as such, there is no grievance left to be redressed. She has also supplied a copy of order dated 10.02.2020 in this regard and the same is taken on record as Mark 'X'.

Faced with the above situation, learned counsel, on instructions from petitioners does not press the petition any further and submits that the same be disposed off.

Ordered accordingly.
