The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in the case bearing FIR
No. 107 dated 12.09.2020 under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC registered at
Police Station Sandaur, District Malerkotla.

Reply by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh, DSP, Sub-Division
Malerkotla on behalf of respondent No.1 has been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner will
surrender in the concerned Court within a period of seven days and has only
restricted his prayer to the extent that an application for regular bail which may
be moved in the trial Court be disposed of expeditiously. Accordingly, he has
sought the withdrawal of the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is directed that in the event,
the petitioner surrenders before the concerned Court within a period of seven
days and moves an application for regular bail, the Court seized of the matter
may look into the feasibility of expeditious disposal of the same.
