This petition was filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.88 dated 9.6.2019, under Sections 406, 408, 409, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar.

Vide order dated 2.9.2019, the petitioner was directed to join investigation subject to complying the condition as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and at this stage his custody is not required.

In view of the statement made, the interim bail granted on 2.9.2019 is made absolute.

However, it is clarified that the State would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case there is change in circumstance.
