RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the award dated 07.11.2014 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2 against the provisions of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947; along with certain other prayers.

On the previous date of hearing following order was passed:

“The counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner has not even discharged his statutory liability as mandated by the provisions of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. Hence, the Court should not continue with the proceedings of the present writ petition.

The counsel for the petitioner seeks time to verify the fact whether any amount has been paid to the petitioner in compliance of provisions of Section 17-B of the Act or not.

Adjourned to 01.08.2022.

However, it is clarified that if the provisions of Section 17-B of the Act is not complied with by the petitioner before the next date of hearing, then the present petition would make itself liable to be dismissed.”

There is no record to show that the petitioner had complied with the previous order. Even the counsel for the petitioner is not sure whether the provisions of Section 17-B of the Act has been complied with or not.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.

All the pending applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
