The petitioner has filed the present petition seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.64 dated 17.07.2022 registered under Sections 302 and 34 IPC at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran by adding the relevant offences and arresting accused/respondents No.4 and 5 with a further prayer to direct respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the witnesses of the case who are being threatened by respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage if an appropriate direction is given to respondent No.2 only regards protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Manipal Singh Atwal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3-State and has no objection in view of limited prayer made hereinabove.

The petitioner is complainant in the FIR No.64 dated 17.07.2022 registered under Sections 302 and 34 IPC at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran and is apprehending threat at the hands of accused Nos.4 and 5. Therefore, In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, only to look into the aspect of protection of life and liberty of the complainant-petitioner in accordance with law.
