Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the last candidate selected in the category, in which the petitioner is competing, secured 112 marks and the present petition will only survive in case the petitioner secures more marks than the marks secured by the last selected candidate otherwise, the question of law raised in the present petition will become academic.

Result of the provisional interview of the petitioner has been produced by the learned State counsel in a sealed cover before this Court.

This Court has opened and perused the result of the provisional interview of the petitioner.

Unfortunately, the petitioner has not been able to secure the marks equivalent or higher than the last candidate selected in the category, in which the petitioner is competing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has not been able to secure marks as obtained by the last selected candidate, the present petition has been rendered academic and the same may be disposed off having been not pressed any further.
