HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0165 dated 14.09.2021, registered under Sections 21 and 29 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Rot Ise khan, District Moga.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case, the petitioner has been indicted on the basis of the disclosure statement of co-accused, namely, Jaswinder Kaur @ Rani and that, in three other cases registered and/or pending against the petitioner, she has been indicted at the behest of Gurvinder Singh, against whom the petitioner has already moved a complaint to the Senior Superintendent of Police on 17.06.2021.

I have heard the learned Senior counsel for the petitioner.

As per para 12 of the petition itself, there are as many as three more cases registered and/or pending against the petitioner and that

too under the NDPS Act. Though in all the three cases, she is on bail, yet the fact remains that she is a person with criminal antecedents. Thus, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a habitual offender having brazen criminal antecedents, she does not deserve concession of the anticipatory bail. Moreover, the nature of the offences committed by the petitioner is sufficient enough to hold that if released on bail, she would again involve herself in similar crime.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
