Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.101 dated 14.12.2021 under Sections 323, 325, 148 and 149 of IPC, P.S. Kheri Nodh Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise dated 08.08.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 07.09.2022, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Ilaqa Magistrate on 20.10.2022 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise and the learned Magistrate was directed to send a report about the genuineness and veracity of the compromise.

A report dated 14.11.2022 of learned JMIC, Khamanon has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Magistrate and got recorded their statements regarding compromise.

Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the

compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.101 dated 14.12.2021 under Sections 323, 325, 148 and 149 of IPC, P.S. Kheri Nodh Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1), along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
