Prayer in the petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for issuance of direction to the Trial Court to expedite the trial in case FIR No.4 dated 10.10.2016 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station NRI, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1) as it is being intentionally delayed by respondent No.2.

Upon instructions from ASI Sukhwant Singh, State counsel submits that there are four accused in this case, namely, Balvir Singh and Paramjit Kaur (petitioners herein), Karamjit Singh, who is a relative and

Dalvir Singh, who is son of the petitioners and husband of the complainant-respondent No.2. He submits that Dalvir Singh has not joined the investigation as he is probably abroad.

Considering the fact that delay is on account of non-cooperation of the accused, prayer made by the petitioner cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed.
