This is an application under Rule 3-A (I) Chapter VI Part B, Vol.V of the High Court Rules and Orders for grant of leave to file the present petition. The application is allowed as prayed for.

CRM-M-41403-2022

This petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.187 dated 8.10.2020 under Section 307, 323, 341, 458, 436, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Dugri, Ludhiana. Earlier, the petitioner was granted bail by the Addl.Sessions Judge on 5.3.2021. However, the petitioner remained absent on 7.6.2022 before the trial court which resulted into cancellation of his bail and forfeiture of bail/surety bonds to the State. The only ground taken by the petitioner for his absence on 7.6.2022 before the trial court is because of his deteriorating health on account of abdominal pain. No medical proof has been placed on record by the petitioner in support of his deteriorating health on account of abdominal pain.

In view of the above, this petition is dismissed.

However, if the petitioner surrenders before the trial court within a week and files an application for regular bail, the trial court will decide the same on the same date when the application is filed.
