**MANOJ BAJAJ, J.**

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0147 dated 02.09.2021 under Sections 384, 406, 420, 506 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Nakodar City, District Jalandhar, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 10.11.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

*“Learned counsel contends that complainant Manju Devi had obtained different finance facilities from different banks for purchase of two wheelers and when the loan installments were not paid by her, the proceedings were initiated by the banks, whereupon she retaliated and lodged this FIR with the allegations that the documentation of loan was got signed by her by force. He contends that the allegations in the FIR are mainly against accused Ranjit Kaur and the petitioner has no role in the alleged transaction. According to him, even the manager of the scooter agency has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail.*

*Notice of motion for 02.03.2022.*

*Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the*

*satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Ajit Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 10.11.2021 is made absolute.
