By this common order, 25 petitions bearing No.CRM-M-34717-2019, CRM-M-34718-2019, CRM-M-34719-2019, CRM-M-39631-2019, CRM-M-39638-2019, CRM-M-39645-2019, CRM-M-39669-2019, CRM-M-39637-2019, CRM-M-39644-2019, CRM-M-39661-2019, CRM-M-40120-2019, CRM-M-44254-2019, CRM-M-44309-2019, CRM-M-44687-2019, CRM-M-44766-2019, CRM-M-44768-2019, CRM-M-44770-2019, CRM-M-44806-2019, CRM-M-44935-2019, CRM-M-45032-2019, CRM-M-45034-2019, CRM-M-45051-2019, CRM-M-45118-2019, CRM-M-45121-2019, and CRM-M-45131-2019 shall stand disposed of.

These are the petitions filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of Criminal Complaint (Annexure P-1) under Sections 138 read with Sections 141 and 142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, has very fairly submitted that the issues raised in the present petitions have been answered in the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P. Mohanraj and others Vs. M/s Shah Brothers Ispat Private Limited** reported as **2021(6) SCC 258** and has further submitted that there have been subsequent developments, after the filing of the present petitions including the development to the effect that personal insolvency proceedings under

Section 96 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 have been initiated against petitioner Nos.2 to 4 and thus, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petitions with liberty to file fresh petitions after incorporating all the relevant facts with respect to the abovesaid plea and other pleas available to the petitioners, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, all the petitions are dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
