AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case of FIR No. 83 dated 6.6.2022 under Sections 409, 468, 471 IPC, 1860 and under Sections 13(1)(C) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (Amended Act 2018) registered at P.S. City Nawanshahar, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time and realizing that the earlier petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 1.8.2022 and the following order was passed :-

“This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 83 dated 6.6.2022, under Sections 409, 468, 471 IPC and Section 13(1)C of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station City Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar.

After arguing for some time and realising that his contentions are not finding favour, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

Learned Counsel for the petitioner on instructions restricts his prayer that the petitioner would surrender within one week from today and apply for regular bail, the same be decided in a time bound manner.

The petition is dismissed as not pressed.

In case the petitioner surrenders within one week from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within two days and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
