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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 56 dated 17.07.2019 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, district Jalandhar on the basis of a written compromise dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) between the parties.

On 04.12.2020, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court upto 27.01.2021 for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise, who in turn was directed to submit a report along with the recorded statements with regard to the veracity of the compromise between the parties.

As directed, report dated 15.06.2021 from the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar has been received, as per which the

parties had recorded their statements before the trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them.

Learned State counsel has also raised no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR, which is arising out of a matrimonial dispute and the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash FIR No. 56 dated 17.07.2019 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, district Jalandhar and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.
