SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Judge concerned, to conclude the trial arising out of FIR No.166 dated 18.12.2020, registered at Police Station STF, Phase- 4, SAS Nagar, Mohali under Sections 21, 25, 29-61-85 of the NDPS Act, rather positively within three months from today, with a further direction to the learned trial Judge concerned, to ensure that the prosecution witnesses concerned are examined on a day-to-day basis.

2. It is clarified that no further extension of time shall either be asked for by the learned trial Judge concerned, nor shall be granted by this Court.

3. However, if the trial as arises from the petition FIR is not concluded within the above period of time, thereupon, the petitioner may re-access this Court but subject to the condition that the learned defence counsel shall not ask for any adjournments for making cross examination(s) on the appearing prosecution witnessess, as and when the sessions case, is listed, before the learned trial Judge concerned.
