The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back with the report that his mother has refused to accept the notice.

This is an application filed by the wife of the respondent to transfer the proceedings of a petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing case No.HMA-5-2020, titled as “Chamkaur Singh Vs. Manjeet Kaur”, pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Sangrur, Punjab, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at District, Ludhiana.

The distance between Sangrur and Ludhiana is stated to be 80 km. The respondent is already defending a petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at District Ludhiana. The petitioner is also stated to be having no independent source of income.

Hence, the application is allowed.

The petition under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing case No.HMA-5-2020, titled as “Chamkaur Singh Vs. Manjeet Kaur”, pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Sangrur, Punjab, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at District Ludhiana, Punjab.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The petitioner through her counsel is directed to appear before the transferee Court on 28.02.2022.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
