MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.157 dated 31.08.2021 under Sections 457, 380 and 34 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 28.10.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel has placed reliance upon the order dated 07.10.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed in CRM-M-42073-2021, whereby co-accused Paramjit @ Pamma @ Surinder Pal has been granted the concession of pre arrest bail.

Notice of motion for 11.02.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-42073-2021.”

Since the petitioner failed to join the investigation, another opportunity was granted to him vide order dated 24.02.2022. Today, again learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lakhbir Singh has stated that the petitioner has not complied with the directions given by this Court and has not associated with the investigation of the case.

Resultantly, no case is made out for grant of extra ordinary concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
