Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.173 dated 13.08.2021 under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 29.10.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the allegations made by the complainant, namely, Jamero Devi, are vague and lack material particulars regarding the alleged payment of Rs.40,00,000/- made by complainant's relatives to the accused persons. According to him, admittedly, no amount was parted away by the complainant and the alleged transactions are also quite old, but the FIR has been lodged to falsely implicate the petitioner and others. He states that the petitioner is willing to join the investigation, therefore, her custodial interrogation may not be necessary

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the

event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated herself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Suresh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 29.10.2021 is made absolute.
