ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondents to release the detainee namely Sanjida being the daughter of petitioner, who is being kept in the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned State counsel submits that on enquiry, the detainee disclosed that she is living happily with her husband and also taken the same stand before the concerned Judicial Magistrate.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contented and satisfied in case parents of the detainee-Sanjida are permitted to meet her.

The prayer is innocuous.

Given above, the parents of the detainee-Sanjida shall be permitted to meet her. The in-charge of the Safe House, where the detainee is living with her husband is directed to convene a meeting at 10 AM tomorrow i.e. 13.09.2022. During such meeting, a female employee must be present there. It is clarified that parents of the detainee shall not use derogatory and abusive language and shall not intimidate her. If it happens, the meeting shall be terminated immediately.

The petition is disposed of with the aforementioned observations.
