an affidavit along with Annexures R-4/1 to R-4/9.

Application is allowed subject to just exceptions.

Affidavit along with Annexures R-4/1 to R-4/9 is taken on
record.

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In pursuance to the order passed by this Court on 14.09.2022,
affidavit along with Annexures R-4/1 to R-4/9 has been filed by the private
respondents, which has been taken on record.

Perusal of the same would indicate that the vehicles stand sold
and, therefore, it would be now too late in the day to interfere in the matter,
especially in the light of the observations made by the learned Single Judge
while dismissing the writ petition vide order dated 05.08.2022

that the appellant had not disclosed the correct facts and has rather

concealed the material facts from the Court disentitling him to the equitable relief in exercise of the writ jurisdiction.

The appeal stands disposed of accordingly.

However, it would be open to the appellant to avail of the remedy in accordance with law and the order passed by the Writ Court and in the present appeal shall have no bearing on the said proceedings.
