The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with a grievance that the respondents have issued an advertisement dated 13.08.2016 (Annexure P/1) for appointment of 06 posts of Clerk, but the respondents have selected and appointed 08 clerks, which is incorrect and is contrary to the settled principle of law. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the selection of the candidates (Annexure P/4), which has been declared by the respondents, contained names of 08 candidates, which fact makes it clear that against 06 advertised posts, the respondents were going to appoint 08 persons, which is impermissible.

After notice of motion, the respondents have filed reply.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Surender Kumar, Accountant

from O/o Moti Lal Nehru School of Sports, Sonapat submits that only 06 candidates have been appointed in pursuance to the advertisement and not 08 candidates as being contended by the petitioner. Learned State counsel submits that Annexure P/4 is only a list of provisionally selected candidates and not the list of candidates, who have been appointed. Learned State counsel further submits that the names of two candidates namely Arvind Grewal and Neer Sharma find mentioned in the said list as selected candidates but, they were never offered appointment and only 06 candidates have been appointed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of the learned State counsel, no grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may be disposed off having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
