Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0222 dated 29.08.2021 under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural.

By virtue of the order dated 03.11.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has paid Rs.25000/- as litigation expenses to the respondent-complainant and the

parties have arrived at an amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the same.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 03.11.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
