While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed:-

“Apprehending his arrest in FIR No.68 dated 15.3.2022 for offences punishable under Sections 379-B IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar, the petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr. P.C seeking pre-arrest bail.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG.,Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice. He submits that there is no other case pending against the petitioner and seeks some more time to file reply.

On the request made by learned State counsel, adjourned to 20.12.2022.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. As and when called, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manoj Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

3. In view of above, the interim order dated 15.09.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

4. Petition stands disposed off.
