Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.118 dated 09.08.2022 under Sections 63, 65 of copy Right Act 1957 and under Section 420 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station P.S. Kot Isse Khan, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
