Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for release of pension under “The Haryana State Shubhra Jyotsna Pension and other Facilities Scheme 2018” claiming that the petitioner had actively participated during the period of emergency and faced imprisonment under The Maintenance of Internal Security Act, 1971.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner was found eligible under the said scheme as per Memo No.16/27/2017-4Pro dated 08/11.03.2019. The name of the petitioner figures at Sr.No.19. Despite the same, the pensionary benefits have not been disbursed. He further contends that a legal notice dated 18.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) in this regard has already been sent by the petitioner and he

would be satisfied, in case, the respondents-authorities are directed to take considered decision on the aforesaid legal notice (Annexure P-4) after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Chauhan, A.A.G., Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He has no objection to the prayer of the petitioner being allowed.

In view of the consent recorded as above, the present civil writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the legal notice dated 18.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioner and to pass an appropriate speaking order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
