VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents for issuance of new registration number to the car belonging to the petitioner since the old registration number i.e. PUB-0004 is not being permitted to be used by the Government.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Pardeep Singh Dhillon, Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, SAS Nagar (Mohali) is available on record. The relevant extract of the same is reproduced hereinafter below:

“2. That in the present petition, the petitioner has prayed for the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent Nos.3 and 6 for issuing new registration number to the car of the petitioner ‘Accord Honda’ by getting deposited from him the VIP registration No.PUB 0004 as the petitioner is not being permitted by the Government to run the said vehicle since August 2021.

3. That the petitioner has since been granted new Registration Mark PB 65 BB 0143 to his Accord Honda Car in place of the old Registration No.PUB 0004. The copy of Form No.24 of the said Registration Mark PB 65 BB 0143 allotted to the car of the petitioner is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1.”

A perusal of the above shows that new registration number PB 65 BB 0143 has been allotted to the car of the petitioner. Consequently, the present writ petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of having been rendered as infructuous.
