Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the petitioner is getting lesser pension than his colleagues. Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that as of now, the petitioner should have been given the pension amounting to ₹29,300/- + D.A. whereas, the petitioner is only being given the pension amounting to ₹24,500/- hence, the petitioner is suffering loss every month as he is being denied the entitled pensionary benefits hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner the pension according to his entitlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the demand notice dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order

in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-DHBVNL and raises no objection in deciding the demand notice dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the demand notice, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the demand notice dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-6), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
