1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 17.9.2018, in CWP-5382-2013.

3. Learned Counsel for the petitioner states that order Annexure P-1 in CWP-5382-2013 having been stayed by Hon'ble the Division Bench vide order dated 22.11.2019 in LPA-1894-2019, the instant petition be disposed of as not calling for any orders at this stage, while granting liberty to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the contempt petition in case of vacation of order of stay dated 22.11.2019 in LPA-1894-2019 or the decision of the LPA in favour of the petitioners.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as in view of the

statement of the learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of at this stage as not calling for any action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, against the respondents while granting liberty to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the contempt petition in the eventuality of vacation of order of stay dated 22.11.2019 in LPA-1894-2019 or decision of LPA-1894-2019 in favour of the petitioners.
