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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.1,90,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants in full & final settlement of the claim. Counsel for the appellants further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to all the appellants in the same ratio as apportioned by the learned MACT.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two cheques in the sum of Rs.22,800/- each favouring appellants 2 and 3 and one cheque in the sum of Rs.1,44,400/- favouring appellant No.1-Smt. Sunita Devi Wd/o Gajender Mallah, for & on behalf of appellants 1, 4, 5 & 6 with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 08.04.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
